

## **Admission Rules**

### **of the Faculty of Theology of the Institute of Theology of the EELC**

#### **1. Requirements for commencement of the studies**

##### **1.1. Professional higher education. Theology.**

1.1.1. Nationally recognized certificate of the secondary school education or document certifying the relevant qualification, successfully passed entrance tests and interview.

1.1.2. Entrance tests are testing the knowledge of the Bible and essay writing skills.

##### **1.2. Master's study. Theology (MA)**

1.2.1. Bachelor's degree or diploma of higher education on the basis of professional higher education curriculum or some other relevant qualification in the field of Theology or Bachelor's degree or diploma of higher education on the basis of professional higher education and certified theology studies for 60 ECP.

1.2.2. Entrance tests are the following: a comprehensive test including the materials of the first cycle of the main disciplines in theology and interview.

##### **1.3. Master's study. Studies in Christian Culture.**

1.3.1. Bachelor's degree, diploma of higher education on the basis of professional higher education curriculum some other relevant qualification in any field at an educational institution in Estonia or any other country.

1.3.2. Entrance test is colloquium.

#### **2. Upon applying to study in the Institute the following documents must be submitted:**

Application to the Rector, certificate or diploma of the previous education cycle, 3 photos (3x4), curriculum vitae and a copy of passport or ID card

#### **3. Organisation of entrance tests and matriculation**

3.1. The Dean of the Faculty of Theology gives an order to form 3-5 member reception committees separately for the professional higher education and Master's Study. The committees carry out entrance tests and, based on the results, they compose a statement about the reception. Entrance test results are recorded and presented with the statement to Dean's office within one day since the last test.

3.2. The Dean of the Faculty of Theology will take a look at the records and statements and submits them to the Rector for approval. The students admitted to the Institute based on the Rector's decision are matriculated.
